



2010 ASCE SAN DIEGO YMF STUDENT ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

The San Diego Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers Younger Member Forum (ASCE YMF) is collecting applications for the purpose of awarding student scholarships to those interested in pursuing a degree in civil engineering or a related field at a four-year university. The three scholarships will be awarded as follows:

- 2 ~ **\$1,000** scholarships will be awarded to a University of California San Diego (UCSD) or San Diego State University (SDSU) undergraduate or first year graduate student.
- 1 ~ **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a San Diego region community college student transferring to a four-year university.

ELIGIBILITY

Undergraduate or first year graduate students:

Must be enrolled in a civil engineering program or related field during the current 2009-2010 academic year at UCSD or SDSU. Open to individuals with academic standing of freshman through first year graduate student. International students are also eligible. Students completing their education in Spring/Summer 2010 are not eligible. The award money is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution for the 2010-2011 academic year.

Community college transfer students:

Must be transferring to a four-year university, located in San Diego County, and enrolling in a civil engineering program or related field for the 2010-2011 academic year. International students are also eligible. The award money is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution for the 2010-2011 academic year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- One page application form (attached).
- Resume.
- For university students only:
 - Unofficial transcript or
 - SIGNED letter from an academic advisor (with advisor's contact information) stating number of units/classes taken towards civil engineering or related major and major GPA.



- For community college transfer students only:
 - Unofficial Transcript SIGNED by a college counselor (with counselor's contact information), accompanied with a letter which states student's major and number of units/classes taken towards transferring to a university and GPA.
Note: upon receiving scholarship, proof of enrollment to a university is required.
- One-page essay (choose from one of the following prompts):
 - *Why is the civil engineer's voice essential and vital to the forming of successful sustainable solutions? What role do you see civil engineers taking in sustainable development?*
 - *If the federal government were to further invest in the development of infrastructure, how would you allocate those new resources, and why?*
 - *Briefly discuss a controversial engineering project that affects the San Diego and/or Southern California region. Are you in support of this project? Why or why not? Some examples might include the high-speed rail project, a new Chargers football stadium, recycling San Diego's wastewater into potable drinking water, the toll-road thru Trestles, etc.*
 - *Describe your most meaningful achievements and how they relate to your field of study and your future goals.*

Please indicate prompt in the essay header.
- An interview of the finalists may be required in April 2010.

 - a. Signed application form.
 - b. Resume.
 - c. Transcript or signed letter from academic advisor/counselor – see different requirements for university and community college transfer students.
 - d. Typewritten essay.
